Challenges and Opportunities

Over the past few decades, the issues in output management have radically changed. Most of the transformation is due to the increased importance of electronic documents and the complexity of today's marketplace for both users and suppliers. From the production of a document through revision, delivery to recipients and archival, output management comprises a substantial investment of time, staffing, IT, and financial resources.

While the steps behind document output vary from company to company, all output is ultimately split between paper and electronic formats—those sent by email or to smartphones and tablets. The latter are increasingly viewed as an attractive and cost-saving alternative to traditional paper documents.

In addition, there is an increasing need to observe special conventions and standards, such as adherence to PDF/A for the production of documents for long-term archiving or PDF/UA for people with disabilities.

These needs constitute complex output challenges. Both physical and electronic documents rely on data from different channels across multiple platforms. Some may require conversion of legacy files to more modern print streams so documents can be produced efficiently and cost-effectively. Increasingly, end-to-end output management systems are required to ensure the six imperatives of accurate and reliable document production:

- 1. Streamlining data and document processes.
- 2. Centralizing and controlling data and documents (as well as the devices that process the data).
- 3. Achieving efficient IT processes and reducing costs.
- 4. Delivering data and documents that are accurate and useful for recipients.
- 5. Efficiently processing siloed data from departments across the enterprise.
- 6. Maintaining full compliance despite the complexity of industry regulations.

This last point is especially important. According to IDC's Worldwide Compliance Infrastructure report spanning 2009-12, some 35 percent of the digital data produced in 2012 was for compliance intensive purposes. As regulations increase, ensuring compliance is a critical component of document output management.

Many companies, for examples are challenged by the conversion of large volumes of content (data) from multiple sources into a single efficient system that makes document production more accurate, efficient and cost-effective, regardless of the medium used for delivery. Others face difficulties in making sure changes are made correctly as documents are updated. Still others seek higher levels of automation to streamline processing.

Yet, for many companies, output management remains a collection of disconnected applications that create, modify and convert documents for various output channels. Often, these applications operate on disparate platforms and use data streams that are difficult to coordinate. But these are not insurmountable challenges. Each of the following companies had a document output challenge that was solved using Compart DocBridge technology, which is designed from the ground up to address specific aspects of document output management.

The Challenge:

World Marketing Inc. a subsidiary of the Omaha-World Herald, a Berkshire-Hathaway company, is a premiere end-to-end provider of quality direct mail, fulfillment, and critical document solutions. A new customer presented World Marketing (WM) with a common challenge faced by many organizations today: taking considerable amounts of legacy data, converting it into modern print streams, and generating new documents with increased time, process and cost-efficiencies. What was needed was a way to run these older files on more advanced laser printers.

Additionally, World Marketing needed to ensure the accuracy of data through automation, bypassing the manually intensive processes generally associated with document comparisons. Other requirements included automating the comparison process, maintaining order of mail pieces, controlling and limiting spoilage, and managing the re-run process.

The Solution and Benefits:

To handle the legacy data issue World Marketing initially chose to write their own code to address their client's challenges. This allowed conversions of old file formats into modern data streams but was inefficient and could not handle all document formats. It became clear that a more cost effective and efficient approach was needed. Compart's DocBridge Mill provided some immediate benefits:

- Robust file (input/output) conversion capabilities
- Increased processing speeds capable of handling large volume jobs
- Time required for file conversion reduced from hours to minutes
- Ability to use newer printers

To address and manage document comparison, WM chose Compart DocBridge Delta. This allowed them to automate the quality assurance process and included other benefits:

- Document comparison
- Identifying differences at word-for-word and pixel-to-pixel levels
- Match critical data between new and older versions
- Ensure accurate communications to recipients
- Switch output device without the need to reprocess files

World Marketing found it was easier than expected to integrate conversion and comparison software into their workflow. User adoption is high and WM has begun phasing out other products as they expand the use of Compart DocBridge Mill and Delta.

2. Raising the Bar on Variable Data Accuracy and Efficiency: Data-Mail

- Improve accuracy and efficiency
- Solution: Compart DocBridge Delta

The Challenge:

Data-Mail is working with clients in the finance, insurance, utilities and healthcare sectors. Therefore, accuracy and accountability are vital. As a full-service direct mailer that produces over a billion pieces of correspondence annually, much of this information contains complex personalized variables and customer data.

Compounding the challenge, documents change constantly making traditional proofing methods costly and time consuming. Data-Mail sought a new validation process that would go beyond the basics when comparing documents to recognize subtle differences surrounding the data such as construction, positioning and embedded data.

The Solution and Benefits:

Testing Compart DocBridge Delta, Data-Mail ran comparison tests utilizing several documents to see how it would work with real materials. Proofing speed immediately increased, as did overall accuracy and efficiency. The process improved further as Data-Mail began using PDFs optimized for comparison.

When documents are created, DocBridge Delta compares the original documents to new versions to identify any changes. The quality control process can be altered internally to meet client requirements without disruptions to the proofing process. Data-Mail can now check more pages and handle audits faster and with greater accuracy than when using traditional methods.

- 3. Increased Confidence in Variable Direct Mail Proofing and Production Quality: Japs-Olson
 - Reduce overhead on every job

The Challenge:

Japs-Olson, a large provider of direct mail and commercial printing services, was searching for ways to improve proofing and approval processes for customers' variable direct mail communications. Other challenges included simplifying the information used in production and increasing uptime for variable imaging.

The Solution and Benefits:

Japs-Olson chose Compart's DocBridge Delta for comparison and proofing but had additional requirements that necessitated the use of a software development kit (SDK). Able to catch even minute changes that manual processes could easily overlook, Japs-Olson built four custom applications that eliminated hours of labor and increased accuracy in the areas of review and production.

- Color coded highlighting to differentiate those areas of a document which are variable as opposed to static. This automated a manual process saving time, creating needed efficiency and accuracy.
- Hot Spots is a precision application that identifies a printed area pixel-by-pixel. It allows Japs-Olson to quickly and easily show print placement throughout a press run so print heads can be positioned for optimum performance.
- The Pixel compare tool allows users to pinpoint specific regions of a page when comparing two documents. If a difference is found, the Pixel Compare tool sends an alert to warn technicians of the potential problem. The documents do not have to be identical for comparison because the tool targets specified personalized regions for comparison.

The IJPDS line segments application is related to the Hot Spots function, giving press operators a numerical value to determine start points to precisely position print heads. Prior to automating this process, manual visual inspection and repeated adjustment were needed to ensure accuracy. Now the correct print region is automatically determined saving time and labor.

This added functionality gave Japs-Olson an improved quality control process that was efficient, accurate and that would reduce overhead would on every job.

- 4. Taking Statement Automation to the Bank: Bluegrass Mailing

The Challenge:

A regional Kentucky bank was overwhelmed with outdated manual processes that interfered with statement printing and production. The manual process of collecting statements was dysfunctional and statements had to be obtained from 10 different locations. Each site had its own systems, data and envelopes that compounded the problem.

Searching for a better way to handle these processes, the bank went to Bluegrass Mailing in Lexington, Kentucky. Initially, Bluegrass gathered the statements and transported them to their facility where each statement was metered, presorted and mailed, but this was an unwieldy and manual process. Bluegrass wanted to automate and consolidate statement workflow. Having files sent from the bank in PDF format was one option but was problematic because the files were so large, and Bluegrass still needed to convert the PDFs for printing.

Using DocBridge Mill Plus, Bluegrass was able to significantly streamline the entire process.
